BLACK MAGIC DO'S AND DONT'S

DO'S

- ✓ Store the adhesive above 15 °C before using. (Hotbox/Heater)
- ✓ Block has to be positioned within 10-15 seconds after the adhesive is dosed

DONT'S

- ✗ Use it when product temperature is below 15 °C
- ✗ Movement of the block during curing process
- ✗ Avoid too much heat in the claw or block
- ✗ Cool it down in water



BLACK MAGIC

VS

MOO GLUE

Fast curing polyurethane adhesive with a guaranteed solid adhesion.

After only 90 seconds the adhesive is fully set

Thixotropic / Viscous

Open time functions as an actual pause

Open time prolongs the etching time

Open time before glue sets is 20 seconds (+/- by temperature), allowing for proper placement prior to glue setting.

Black Magic is thick which provides a better adherence and does not drip like other adhesives.

Thinner glue which makes it more runny.

Mini moo has air bubbles in both sides you have to purge out.

Mini Mini moo drips where you have too thin of an adhesive layer by the time you get the block flipped up on the claw.

You will never get a good bond with a thin layer of glue.
